### Travelling to Aberdeen

Arrival on either Monday evening (10<sup>th</sup>) or the morning of the 11<sup>th</sup> October to Aberdeen.

This central location is a 5-minute walk from the Aberdeen Harbour where the boat trip to Kincardine will depart early morning. The duration of the boat trip (weather dependent) will be approx. 2 hours + safety brief and return in time for the working lunch available from 12.30pm and afternoon sessions held at the museum.
