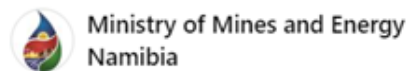


Delegation visit to Namibia

Namibia – The African Oil & Gas frontrunner

Namibia has during the last year(s) made large oil and gas discoveries, and Namibia is forecasted to be a frontrunner within oil & gas production in Africa during the next years. Norway has been recognized with special knowhow in deep-water operations as well as low emission technology. The Namibian Government and the Ministry of Mines and Energy will shortly after the Norwegian delegation visit Norway to underline the relationship to Norway (Namibian official visit to Norway will take place 5 – 9th of June 2023).

It is officially recognized that Namibia is lack of infrastructure, knowhow, human and financial capital, and technology that is required to handle the rapid growth. During the last months NORWEP have been called for several meeting by the Ministry due to Norway capability to build a solid Oil & Gas industry as well as a National financial platform during the last decades. Namibia is aiming for a similar situation.

The Namibian delegation program is organized by Norwegian Energy Partners (NORWEP) with the Namibia Ministry of Mines and Energy as co-sponsor.

The Namibia Ministry of Mines and Energy have requested all operating company and other key stakeholders to join the event (Part 1).

It should be noted that is easy to travel to Namibia as Visa is not required. Namibia is also a friendly country and relatively easy to do business. How to do business will also be part of the Delegation program.

There are further discoveries and ongoing exploration ongoing in Namibia such as; Total Energies, Shell, BW Energy, Galp Energia as well as Namcor, ExxonMobil, Chevron, Eco Atlantic, Maurel & Prom, Global Petroleum and Atlas Petroleum. These companies have also been invited to the event.
